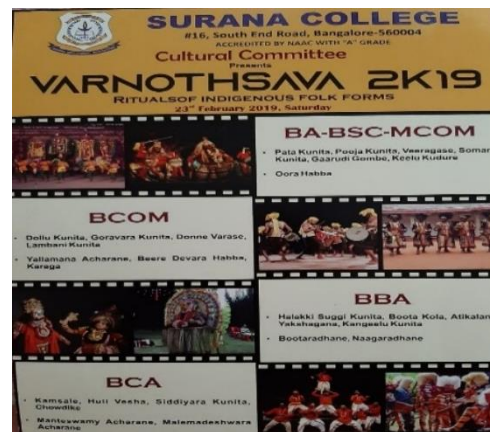
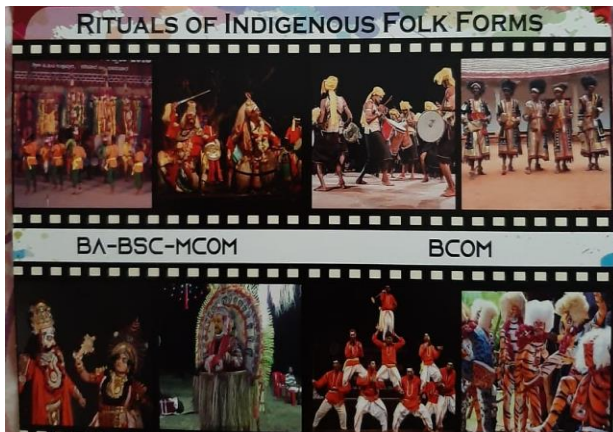
BEST PRACTICE – 1 TITLE: Indigenous Language Year
