



1. INTRODUCTION OF THE COURSE

Statistics education research over the last decade has pointed out the development of statistical literacy and interpretive skills as a universally recognized goal of instruction (Rumsey, 2002; Delmas, 2002). Chance (1997) argued that as instructional goals in statistics courses change emphasizing statistical literacy skills over procedural calculations, there is need for instructors to accompany these new goals with more authentic assessment techniques to evaluate progress towards these goals. This course is designed to adopt Gal's conception of adult statistical literacy as "the ability to interpret, critically evaluate, and communicate about statistical information and messages" (Gal, 2002). Gal's statistical literacy model comprises two broad interrelated components; namely: (1) knowledge component which consists of five cognitive elements: literacy skills, statistical knowledge, mathematical knowledge, context knowledge, and critical questions; and (2) dispositional component which consists of three related but distinct concepts; namely: critical stance, beliefs and attitudes.

2. COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. To elevate students' awareness of data in everyday life and prepare them for a career in today's age of information.



- 2. To impart to students, an assured level of competence, or understanding, of the basic ideas, terms, and language of statistics.
- 3. To develop statistical literacy skills in students in order to comprehend and practice statistical ideas at many different levels.
- 4. To promote the practice of the scientific method in our students: the ability to identify questions, collect evidence (data), discover and apply tools to interpret the data, and communicate and exchange results.

3. COURSE OUTCOMES (COs)

- 1. Students will be able to *recognise and list* the fundamentals of statistical applications and its prominent uses in modern day business functions
- 2. Students will be able to *classify* various statistical models and *distinguish* the models based on changing business scenario
- 3. Students will be able to *apply* the various statistical models in complex business situations
- 4. Students will be able to critically *compare* the statistical tools by relating the assumptions and *employ* the appropriate tool
