"ESOTERIC" is a IT club started by computer science department on 31st may 2002.

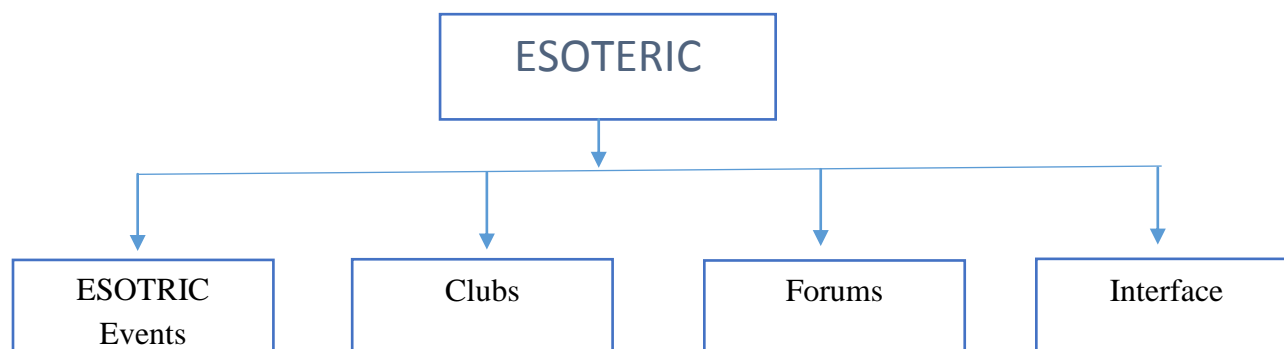
