Policy of the student's council

- The student council will be formed, completely by means of fair election of member students according to the predetermined ratio and criterion.
- The student council is made functional by issuing the job description of each member and delegation of tasks thereto.
- The student council shall function in the most flexible manner taking into consideration the opinions of all class representative [though the latter does not form a part of committee.
- The committee shall meet frequently, as per the plan of action.
- The meeting shall form a quorum only when 75% of the committee's composition is present.
- The decision shall be adopted only if 75% of the quorum agreed with it.
- The meeting shall be chaired by the chairperson or any other cadre so appointed.
- The committee's meeting shall be recorded as minutes of meeting by secretary of the student council.
- The student council can expel any of the members, if the latter is found guilty in any of the undesired happening, and the student council will ensure that the expelled member is counselled and mediated for future wellbeing.

Student Council

Introduction:

The council members are closely monitored by the appointed coordinator (Faculty member) to keep the council running in an organized manner. The council meets on the frequent basis to discuss various initiatives and plan the events for student betterment programs, and delegate various roles to be played by the members.

The council's role can be broadly classified in to 2 categories to meet the needs Academic & Administrative of our students.

Academics:

The council members organize various training & simulation programs to assist other students by providing them the information, assistance in registration processes of various competitions held within and outside college and also organizing fests and summits as host to other institutions.

The scope of Surana College student's council is as follows:

Advisory

The student's council with the help of its student members, plays a vital role as an advisory body to the management of the college in taking up the decisions related to academics, organizing competition and enhancing the pedagogy fashion to keep abreast all the training programs with that of the market needs. The students meet frequently to conduct meetings and update the management about the periodic progress taking place.

Sponsorship and Brand association:

The college organizes various events within and outside college, the events are often associated with the other institution, establishments, and brands with an objective of either to establish financial association or increasing the promotional coverage events. The students from the council along with other students take initiatives to bring various brands and institutional establishments together to fulfill the fore said objectives and provide the management required information of these sources as and when called for.

Simulation programs:

The students take initiatives to conducts different competitions from academics to cultural, to provide the other students, a platform to exhibit their talents and to be aware with the competitive environment at state and national level.
