The Mob resulted to be A Smashing Hit to the Avenue of PR as the Performances was Under Witness of 400+ rotaractors to the club.



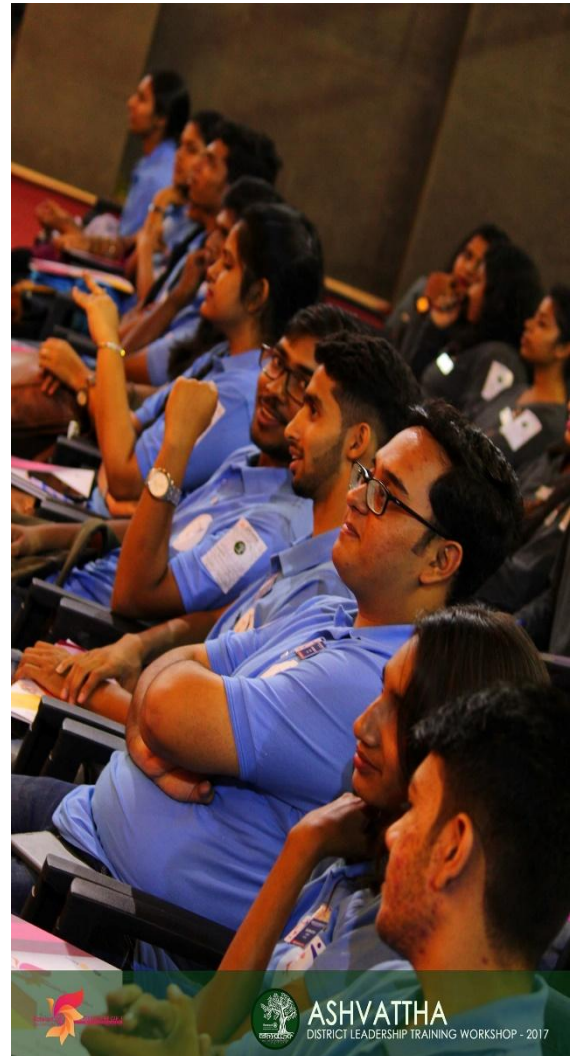
3) DLTW (District Leadership Training Workshop)

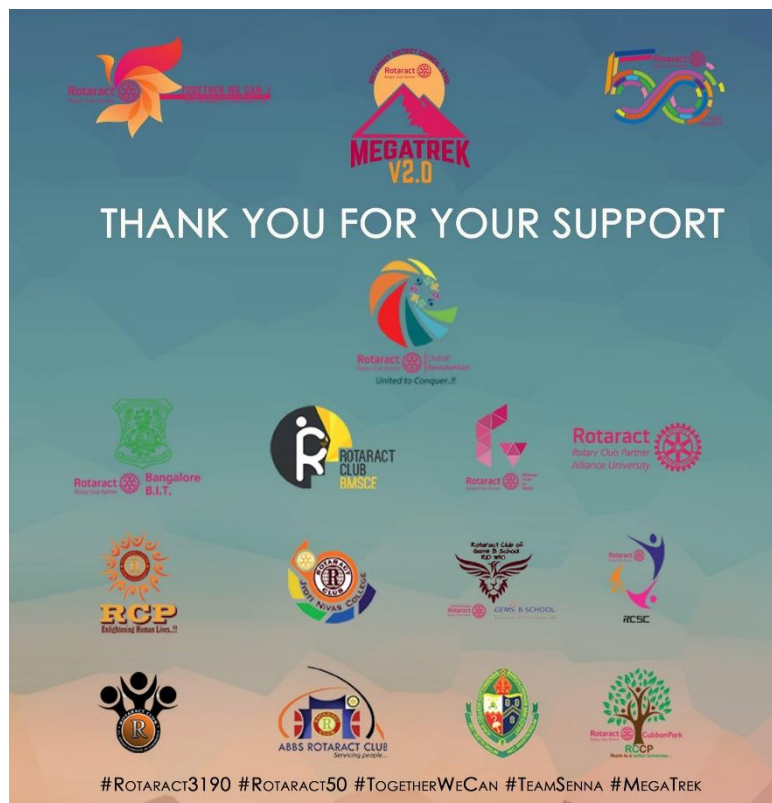
Joint Project.

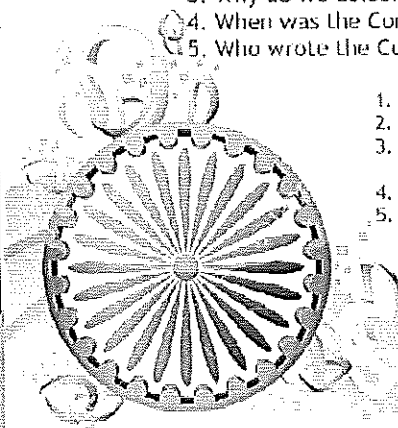
KNOW OUR CONSTITUTION
